

Location-Specific Visa Requirements

- ◆ EAPSI participants are responsible for the following:
 - ✚ Preparing for their own travel.
 - ✚ Obtaining passports, visas and any other required travel documents.
 - ✚ Any visa application and/or processing fees
 - ✚ Identifying and making the necessary arrangements with an expeditor service, where relevant.
- ◆ Please note that visa requirements and fees are subject to change. We strongly recommend that prior to travel you contact the Embassy to inquire about visa requirements to enter your location.

✚ Australia

- ◆ A valid passport with at least six months of remaining validity
- ◆ Visa type – Short validity business ETA visa
- ◆ NSF letter confirming acceptance (letter will be provided)

✚ China

- ◆ A valid passport with at least six months of remaining validity and with at least two blank visa pages
- ◆ Visa type – “F” or “Business” visa

- ◆ NSF and CSTE letters confirming acceptance (letters will be provided)
- ◆ One original passport photo on paper, stapled to the visa application

✚ Japan

- ◆ Visa **not** required for U.S. citizens on stays up to 90 days. If you intend to stay longer than 90 days, you will need to make the necessary visa arrangements.

✚ Korea

- ◆ Visa **not** required for U.S. citizens on stays up to 90 days. If you intend to stay longer than 90 days, you will need to make the necessary visa arrangements.

✚ New Zealand

- ◆ A valid passport with at least six months of remaining validity
- ◆ Visa type – General work visa
- ◆ Completed application form (NZIS 1015)
- ◆ A brief cover letter stating that you are an EAPSI participant and that you are applying for a general work visa under policy WE1 (b)
- ◆ NSF letter confirming acceptance, length of program, and stipend (*will be provided*)
- ◆ Letter from host researcher confirming position, title, and RSNZ stipend
- ◆ One passport-sized photo
- ◆ Flight itinerary

✚ Singapore

- ◆ A valid passport with at least six months of remaining validity
- ◆ Visa **not** required for U.S. citizens on stays up to 90 days. If you intend to stay longer than 90 days, you will need to make the necessary visa arrangements.

✚ Taiwan

- ◆ A valid passport with at least six months of remaining validity
- ◆ Visa type – Single entry visitor visa
- ◆ NSF letter confirming acceptance (letter will be provided)
- ◆ Two passport-sized photos
- ◆ Flight itinerary
